She was diagnosed with tonsillitis about three weeks ago, but it may have been a misdiagnosis and now she has had malaria. It is the rainy season here too, so I guess it is fairly inevitable that it should be around at this time of year!

Well it has been a week today, after seven days in the hospital and on a drip twice a day, our sweet Bernice is home, malaria free and back in her own bed.
